Major Section Events in 2023

SMI 2023 Discussed the SMI 2023 conference hosted by the University of Minnesota and organized my Mark Fiecas. Highlighted the keynote lectures, founders talk, educational program, and scientific program of 16 invited sessions and a poster session. There were 116 Attendees (64 students/postdocs and 52 faculty). Discussed that this year there were two tracks for the student paper competition.

SI Virtual Working Group

- Discussed the Statistics in Imaging Virtual Working group, which was established in 2022. Julia Fisher is the current group leader. Daniel Spencer is the former group leader (2022). - Discussed the new Statistics in Imaging Website. The website was launched on August 2nd.

- Daniel Rowe suggested adding a place for students to mention that they are looking for jobs. The website is going to be modified to allow this.
- There was additional discussion of adding resources linking to publicly available data and featured papers.

SI Section Growth

- Ying Guo showed ASA's report for SI section's finances, which are in good shape. Some major expenses this year included the payment for JSM student paper competition awards and the partial support for the neuroimaging workshop at OHBM.
- Section membership has continued to increase with faster membership growth in recent years. As of August 1st, 2023, SI had 471 members.

JSM 2024

- Kristin Linn discussed invited session proposal solicitation for JSM 2024 in Portland. This will be going out soon.
- The theme of JSM 2024 will be informing policy and countering information. There is a higher likelihood of getting more invited sessions if they tie in with this theme.
- Members were also encouraged to submit introductory overview lectures for JSM 2024.

Council of Sections Meeting Items

- Joshua Lukemire presented some main points from the 2023 JSM Council of Sections Meeting.
- Total ASA section membership has increased by 11% from 2022. SI had a 30% increase.
- JSM invited session allocations are going to be reviewed in 2024 for all sections. This review had been on hold due to COVID.
- SI will be eligible to present the Outstanding Section Service Award in 2024. The selections are made by the sections using their own criteria, and the final selection is made by the section Executive Committee. The previous recipient of the SI Outstanding Section Service award was Timothy Johnson in 2021.

Open Discussions

- There was discussion of holding a section mixer. The high cost of reserving space and food for a mixer was raised. It was pointed out that we previously had a joint mixer with mental health. Another suggestion was that the mixer be held off site and that members RSVP. There was also discussion of combining the business meeting and mixer in future years. It was suggested that SI hold a short course at JSM to raise money. The session would require a proposal from the section.
